Founded in 2001, Houston Center for Contemporary Craft (HCCC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit arts organization with a mission to inspire and connect people to the art and process of making. Focused on objects made from **clay, fiber, glass, metal, wood**, and **mixed media** and recognized for leading-edge exhibitions and scholarship, HCCC is one of the few venues in the country dedicated exclusively to fine contemporary craft in all media.

HCCC educational programming highlights craft as interdisciplinary. Natural dyeing educates guests about the environment, botany, and chemistry while sewing a quilt square connects students with color and texture as well as geometry and culture.

HCCC's most popular programs include:

Hands-on Houston is one of the longest running and most popular free art programs in the city. This monthly making event provides artists, families, and community members with informal learning opportunities. More than 45,000 individuals have engaged with Hands-on Houston since its inception.

HCCC's annual **Craft Community Day** draws hundreds of visitors who want to connect with our resident artists and the two dozen local craft groups we host, such as Contemporary Handweavers of Houston and Gulf Coast Woodturners. Together we present make-and-take activities, demonstrations, and gallery tours.

HCCC hosts free drop-in programming for families during **Spring Break**, inviting participants to experiment with different materials, tools, and a new art project each day.
